

The RISE Adextends eligibility for Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) gift assistance programs. These programs include the Monetary Award Program (MAP), the Minority Teachers of Illinois (MTI) Scholarship Program and the Illinois Special Education Teacher Tuition Waiver (SETTW) Program. Students are not exempted from meeting existing program eligibility criteria.

Students must provide Northeastern Illinois University Admissions Office with an affidavit stating that an application will be filed to become a permanent resident of the United States at the earliest opportunity the student is eligible to do so.
