## Learning with Peers

29% of FY students and 63% of seniors frequently worked with their peers on course projects and assignments.

52% of seniors frequently worked with peers on course projects and assignments.

How often do students interact with others who have different viewpoints or who come from different backgrounds?<sup>b</sup>

Among FY students, 44% frequently had discussions with people with different political views, 54% frequently had discussions with people from different economic backgrounds, and 50% frequently had discussions with people from different races or ethnicities.

How do students rate their interactions with academic advisors?<sup>c</sup>

How many students study in other countries?

55% of FY students and 57% of seniors said at least some of their courses included a community-based service-learning project.

### Notes

- Highly is a 6 or 7 on a seven-point scale where 1 is "Not at all" and 7 is "Very much."
- Frequently is "Often" or "Very often."
- A "High" rating is a 6 or 7 on a seven-point scale where 1 is "Poor" and 7 is "Excellent."
- Substantially is "Quite a bit" or "Very much."
- At least some is defined by combining responses of "Some," "Most," and "All."
