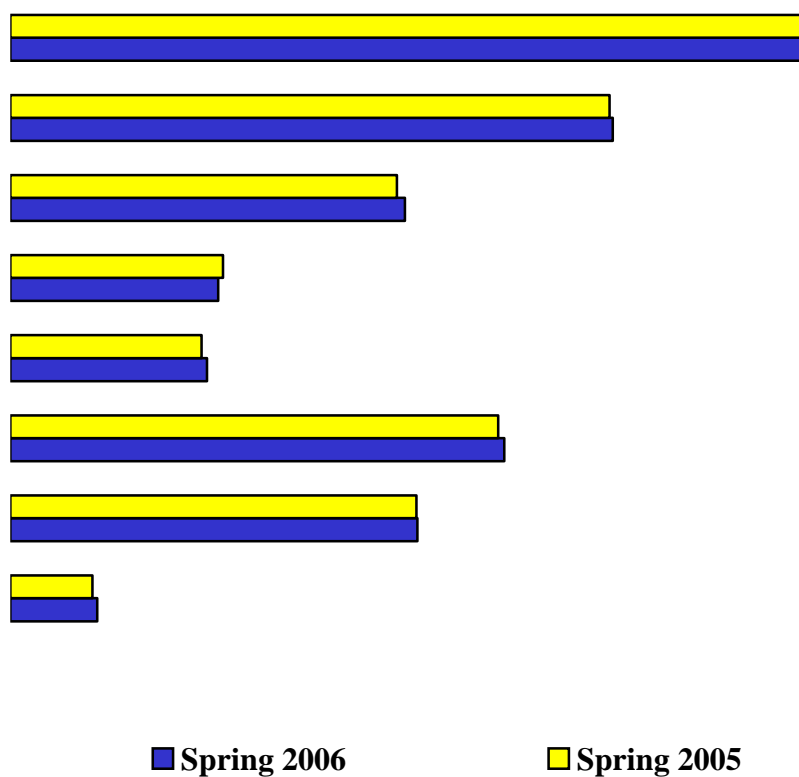




Enrollment Fact Sheet Spring, 2006

Office of Institutional Studies and Planning



- In spring 2006, overall student enrollment and student FTE showed a slight increase of 1.1% and 1.2%, respectively.
- An analysis of changes that have taken place in the spring semesters over a five-year period shows modest increases for important institutional indicators.
 - Between spring 2002 and spring 2006, overall enrollment increased 5.8%, undergraduate enrollment grew slightly more at 7.3%, and overall student FTE grew by 5.8%.
 - During the same period, student credit hour productivity increased at the undergraduate
